Garbage Pick Up

Just a reminder that each household is permitted 2 receptacles for garbage. **All garbage receptacles must have lids that fit tightly** and the containers should not weigh more than 77 lbs. when full. Garbage must be **out by 7 am** for pick-up. If you need to find out what day of the week is your regular garbage pick-up, please call the Town Office at 403-783-4431.



AMVIC LICENSING

You must get a provincial license from AMVIC (Alberta Motor Vehicle Industry Council) if you buy, sell, lease, repair or maintain cars, trucks (all types) or recreation vehicles (motorized only) in Alberta. This includes:



- New, used wholesale, agent/broker or consignment sales (salespeople must also be licensed).
- Body shops, garages, specialty service and repair, mobile service and repair and leasing.

Water Conservation Corner – Water Saving Tips

Check your toilet for leaks.

Put a little food coloring in your toilet tank. If it appears in the bowl without flushing, then you have a leak which should be repaired immediately. Leaks can waste 14% of all the water we use in our home.
