## **World’s Largest Bucking Saddle Bronc Horse & Rider Ponoka, Alberta, CANADA**



On the occasion of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Town of Ponoka in 2004, this monument statue was dedicated to the strength and courage of the pioneer families, the wisdom and vision of the founding fathers, and the dedication of residents of the Town and County of Ponoka who have chosen this place to call HOME.

The Ponoka Lions Club, as project leader, commissioned and had erected a roadside attraction in the **Lion’s Centennial Park** along Highway 2A. Contributing partners to *The Legacy* include: Ponoka Lions Club, Town of Ponoka, Ponoka County, and the Ponoka Stampede Association. The cost of the project was approximately \$80,000.
