ALL businesses operating within Town of Ponoka corporate limits **MUST** have a current and valid business license unless exempted by Provincial Statute. Every business license issued must be posted in a conspicuous place within the business premises. For more information or to apply for a business license, please call 403.783.0119 or 403.783.0117.

House Numbers

House numbers assist emergency response vehicles and others in locating addresses. Thank you to all who have installed house numbers. There remain some homes that need to install house number or upgrade their house numbers to the bylaw minimum size. **Please do so now and avoid receiving a formal notice by way of a violation ticket.**

Public Notice: 2010 Assessment/Tax Notices

The **2010 Combined Assessment/Tax Notices have been prepared and mailed** to all property owners in the Town of Ponoka. The assessment and tax-roll is open for inspection during business hours (9:00 am to 4:30 pm) Monday through Friday until June 30, 2010. Pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, all assessed persons are deemed to have received their assessment/tax notices as a result of the publication of this notice. If you have not received your 2010 assessment/tax notice, please contact the Town Office in person or by calling 403.783.0127.

Bylaw Reminder

As per Town Bylaw 200-06, **trailers (holiday or otherwise) may not be parked on the road unless it is attached to a motor vehicle** by which it is carried, drawn or propelled. When attached



to a motor vehicle, a trailer is deemed to be part of the motor vehicle. The penalty for failing to comply with the Bylaw is a **\$60** fine. In addition, no person shall park a vehicle or holiday trailer on a highway for any continuous period in **excess of 72 hours** or it will be deemed 'abandoned'. Abandoned vehicles are subject to a tow and a **\$230** fine.
