**ALL** businesses operating within Town of Ponoka corporate limits **MUST** have a current and valid business license unless exempted by Provincial Statute. Every business license issued, must be posted in a conspicuous place within the business premises. For more information or to apply for a business license, please call 403.783.0119 or 403.783.0117.

## **House Numbers**

House numbers assist emergency response vehicles and others in locating addresses. Thank you to all who have installed house numbers. There remain some homes that need to install house number or upgrade their house numbers to the bylaw minimum size. **Please do so now and avoid receiving a formal notice by way of a violation ticket.**

0 - 15 m (0 - 49.2 ft.)	10 cm (4in.)	7.5 cm (3 in.)
15 - 20 m (49.2 - 65.6 ft.)	15 cm (6 in.)	10 cm (4 in.)
Greater than 20 m (65.6 ft.)	20 cm (8 in.)	15 cm (6 in.)

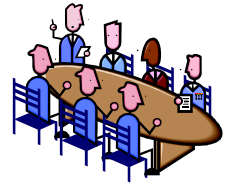
